# Housing, Homelessness, and Beyond – *Tackling California's Biggest Issues*

Senator Scott Wiener (D – San Francisco) has built a reputation as a legislator unafraid to tackle California's toughest issues in bold and thoughtful ways. In his first term, he passed legislation that created the strongest net neutrality protections in the nation, modernized eyewitness protection standards, expanded LGBTQ+ rights, and streamlined housing approvals in cities that are not meeting their housing goals. He also authored major housing legislation that would prevent localities from blocking the construction of apartment buildings and high density housing near major transportation and job hubs, and continues to lead the fight to end California's housing crisis.
